The person managing golf course supervisors **must** be a competent golf course supervisor and must also be competent in the following tasks

Making decisions and recommendations in accordance with employment law, health and safety law and environmental policies and practices

Make recommendations on and implement a golf course maintenance policy

Manage the golf course environment

Managing meetings

Communicating to staff, colleagues, other managers, golfers and others

Briefing teams, managers and golfers

Managing budgets and finance

Manage the recruitment, selection and induction of staff

Managing the performance, training and development of self and staff

Manage conflict, discipline and grievance

Promoting the values and characteristics of the golf club

## 2. Managing the development of the golf course

Managing the construction of golf course features

Recommending and managing golf course development policies

Managing projects

## 3. Managing the maintenance of the golf course

Manage golf course maintenance in accordance with the golf course policy document
